





What are training participants saying?

By centering the voice and choice of youth and families, HFW ensures meaningful outcomes for families by making them active participants in shaping their own future, helping them to feel heard, respected, and supported.

Stronger Bonds

Assistance Plus believes HFW, especially peer support, will have a transformative impact on youth and families. Peer supports are vital to improving the quality of care and reducing out-of-home placements, while making stronger bonds for families within their local communities. Assistance Plus is excited for Wraparound's holistic, team-based approach that brings together families, providers, and natural support to create a plan that reflects the strengths, voice, and choice of the youth and family, building resilience, connection, and long-term stability.
